We know that times are difficult for everyone during this current health care crisis, especially the isolated, lonely and frail. Our focus is to reach the seniors who are most vulnerable and lack access to services needed to improve their quality of life and meet life’s basic needs.

We have created a “COVID-19 Health Crisis Plan” that allows us to continue providing the outreach to ensure that the isolated, now mandated to be home bound, clients are receiving the necessities for daily living. Engagement Services, intake process, depression screenings, Emergency Utility and Rent Services and Referral Services are still transpiring, but limited to phone conversations, to protect the safety and decrease the health risk to our elderly population.

In lieu of the facility suspension/closures, we have transitioned our congregate meal lunch program to a meal delivery directly to the clients residence. This ensures that the clients are home safe and still receiving the nutritional lunch each day.

For those who are not home bound, we host a monthly food bank at our agency which is located at 10953 14th Avenue, Armona CA 93202. To be sure that all are safe, we have made this a drive thru / no contact event. We contract with the Community Food Bank and on the first Wednesday of every month we are able to provide this service. We welcome any individual that is in need to attend.
